Dear Lou,

Two of the other telephone numbers on the phone at the Kirkpatrick residence, of which I have written you earlier, are those of the White House and the Soviet Embassy. The latter is in Oswald's notebook twice, 18H40, 61.

Further checking will have to await the availability of the Washington blue book and someone with the time to use it for me. I'll let you know if and when I learn more.

I have asked for a transcript of the tapes of my conversations with Harry Morgan on the threat to kill Jim. Somehow, when they were Xeroxed, I was given only the last one. Although I have already written that part of the book in which I include it, I'd still appreciate a copy in the event I can go back and pick up the exact words.

You will recall I told you of some information I picked up on Thornley and his intentions when I was down there. We have now transcribed my source and I am satisfied it is as represented. You have a memo on this. My wife, whose skepticism matches yours, is also of this opinion. She did the transcribing. This does not answer the question of my source's source. I think the one specified is possible.
