FRAME-UP: The Alarint Iuther King'James Eal Nay Cam Containimg Suppressell Evidence. I'maschipt liy James Earl Ray. Harohl Weisbers. Outerbridge (Dutton, dist.), $\$ 10$
Weisberg sprang into rational prominence with his book "Whitewash," about the Warren Report. Here, in massive detail, he deserites his investigations into what be calls the "Iraming" of James Farl Ray as the murderer of Martin luther King in 1968. It is an extraordinarily gripping book. Weizherg attempts to pet at the actual criderice that would have, he says, been presented and tested by cross-exambation-with resulis unfavorable to the prosecutionhad thore been wiat he defines as a full-scale trial of Ray instead of the "minitrial" that took place March 10 , 1969. He contends that Ray did not shoot King, but was the decoy for the actual criminals.

This review can barely uegest the detuiled number of Wenberg's charges, speculations, freshly documented evidence and revelations aboit the King murder. In two atreas he is pure TNT: his attack on Ray's lawyer. Perey Foreman, and Bradford Huie an "scavenger"" and his sensational head-un assoult on J. Edgar Hoover, the FBI and the government itself for what he claims was suppressing of official evidence indicating Ray was not alone in the King assassination. Crank or supersteath, Weisberg. for all his turgid writing has brought forth a blistering book.

Weisberg is an indefatigable researcher.
But when all this has been said, Weis-bera-remains invaluable. He has pursucd the facts, and they are there. buried in the mass of his book. And they are facts that lay claim to the conscience of America. For it should be clear by now that, if the assassinations of some of the nation's most outstanding leaders are to be dismissed with the "one man-no conspiracy" refrain, there will be no deterrent to conspiracies in the future whencver hate may point the way and pull the trigger. And, in that event, this greatest of democracies will have been reduced to the status of a Latin American banana republic. That is the issue.

Adjoining arc the prepublication review in the leading trade publication, Publishers' Hecky (whose reviewer considers MANEUF one of the three best books he has read in a year), and excerpts from a two-page review in the Saturday Reviev of Literature, most of which is devoted to evidence here brought to light for the first time. For the "trade press", these are "rave" reviews, esvecially for the work of the inventor of the "underground" book.
