1 TRAVEL TO NEW ORLEANS MAY 4, 1968

2 On this date I met LORAN HALL at the airport terminal
3 of National Airlines at Los Angeles International Airport. I
4 gave HALL \$250.00 to pay for his trip and expenses and he signed
5 a receipt to that effect. (see xerox of receipt) HALL stated that
6 he had spoken with GERRY PATRICK at KHJ after the press conference
7 and had exchanged information and compared some names with him.
8 In particular, he noted the names TED SLACK and JOHN BLOOMER (See
9 memo on GERRY PATRICK HEMMING of May 4, 1968) HALL stated that
10 he did not recall a TED SLACK, however, he might have encountered
11 a JOHN BLOOMER after he (HALL) returned from Cuba in 1959 or 1960.
12 This meeting, he said, would have been at the KANSAS CITY HOTEL.
13 HALL said that he was in WICHITA, KANSAS, and received a call and
14 later met with a man regarding a possible invasion of Nicaragua.
15 HALL also stated that a LACALLA FARFAN (Spanish name), and a
16 man named CHESTER LACALLA were having meetings for this purpose.
17 HALL said that he had made a 5½ hour tape recording of information
18 which he felt was pertinent to the investigation and had left this
19 in a place known only to himself and PAUL EBERLE, of the Los
20 Angeles Free Press Newspaper.

21 HALL departed International Airport on Flight #34,
22 nonstop Los Angeles-New Orleans, under the pseudonym of "RAY
23 CROWLER." (see xerox attached).

25 NOTE: On April 29, 1968 I asked HALL if he had any recollection
26 of a man named "RALPH" or "SKINNY RALPH," and he had none.
