## On the Death by Assassination of Robert F. Kennedy

On June 6, 1968 I was asked by LA Suisse, Newspapeer in Geneva for a stateath of the attempted assassination of Sen. Robert Kennedy. I was asked because of my status as a staff member for the office of D.A. Garrison.

I gave the following statement which wast revised to nolonger containt the world a " attempted" after the Senator died.

> Q: That is your reaction to the attempted assassination of Robert Kennedy?

A: The American people, expecially the American press, have turned their backs on the assassination of the President for five years. They were content to make him a martyr and to produce monuments of their sympathy but they refused to question the United States Government's official conclusion that the President was killed by one man. SEXX

Some wery courageous people worked long and had to bring out the truth "... I speak of wark Lane, the other critics of the marren Report and District attorney Jim Gerrison. They proved that the official conclusion of the government was untrue. Still the American recole, despite their admitted realization of this falsehood, continued to dismiss the shocking probability that a conspiracy had occured where the conspirators went free.

Then, Dr: Martin Luther King was assassinated. The Federal Government intervened in the investigation of thet murder. Once again the assassin went free.

Althought the American people have not responded to the reality that assassination has becore a political instrument of our country they must know that to allow this is to allow democracy to desintegrate.

Last week, after one-and-a-half-years of awaiting trial for a man who has been charged by District Attorney Carrison with conspiracy in the murder of President John F. Kennedy, the Federal government's court in New Orleans became the place of interventtion as before. The trial which had been postponed so long by actions of the defense of the man charged, Clay Shaw, was cancelled indefinately. Justice has perished and law is no longer the cornerstone of the democratic system in the United States of America.

A suit was filed against the duly elected district attorney of New Orleans Jin Garrison, claiming that in his pursuit of the true assassing of Fresident Neumody he was conducting a " reign of terror, " and asking that the official findings of the Sarren Report, that Lee Marvey Oswald alone killed the president, be upheld by the Federal Court.

One can understand, in view of this kind of subversion of justice, how every great leader who esponses the feture of real freedom, could be assassinated. Senator Robert Hennedy brought the Perican Boogle the chance to recepture the dreams of John Kennedy, peace, equality and democracy for all wan. Repert Fennedy was on the threshold of regaining these goals. But the assassing had goes free and could easily return to convit their terror once again.

## 2- Statement to La Suisse

People have blamed Jin Garrison for engaging in a "reing of terror" for accusing the Central Intelligence agency, more precisely members of thet agoncy, of being responsible for the nurder of John F. Kennedy. But the Federal government has never allowed him to prove is allegations in a court of law, in fact, they have done everything presible to obstruct and preclude his investigation. Garrison is no more guilty of such accusations' than the doctor who diagnosis a patient's illness is guilty of causing the patient to be come sick.

Senator Kennedy#s attempted assassination is the most tragic of all. it is the extreme demonstration of where our country's tolerance of corruption is today. Wad the American people demanded the truth about the assassination of President Kennedy, or even later demanded that Carrison be allowed to present his case in court, this disgusting act of terror might have been avoided in the case of the shooting of Robert Kennedy.

I only hope that the Azerican/cople will throw off thier cloak of anathy now, and aska for the truth.

Q: Do you think that the murderers of President Kennedy are the same as the people who have attempted to the assassination of his brother Robert Kennedy?

A: It is impossible to specualte as to the exact origin of the attempted assassination of Senator Kenned, because we have no possible way of evaluating, the evidence at such an early hour.

It is a certainty, in my opinion, that the attempted assassination of Senator Kennedy was for the same reasons as his prother's murder.
