On November 16, 1967, in the office of
STANLEY K. SHEINBAUM, at the Center for the Study of Democratic
Institutions, Santa Barbara, we met with ED FOLEY a local radio
broadcaster. He offered us the names of conservatives in the
area who would be of help to us if we desired. He also mentioned
that he knew a man who was extremely valuable to us in terms of
his knowledge of the Bay of Pigs invasion forces and Anti-Castro
groups in Florida in 1963.

FOLEY stated that this person was known to him as
"VINCE" although that was not his real name. He told us that
VINCE had been a pilot during the Invasion and was connected
with the CIA. Since then, he'd broken all relations with the
CIA and was being pursued by that agency for arrest. He (FOLEY)
agreed to try and set up a meeting with VINCE and myself. This
meeting took place on the 3rd of January, 1968 with VINCE who
is now known to us as JIM ROSE.

RE: INTERVIEW WITH JIM ROSE ABOUT HIS ANTI-CASTRO ACQUAINTANCES

I spoke with JIM ROSE upon his return from a visit he had with LAWRENCE HOWARD to try and bring out any information which the two of them knew. ROSE advised that there will be a forthcoming story in TRUE MAGAZINE about some invasion or raid in which he was a pilot or in which he had some involvement, under a different identity.

The most important result of this meeting with ROSE was that in showing him an article written by ROBERT K. BROWN in GUN WORLD MAGAZINE, P. 27, January 1965, ROSE determined upon examination of the photos in the story that the man listed as "the author" (BROWN) had been his room-mate in a hotel in Florida during one day before the invasion of Haiti. BROWN whose photo ROSE recognized was described by him as a man who "radiates death." BROWN, he said, is interested in killing for killing's sake and had no real moral interest in the invasion. After one night of sharing a room ROSE decided he'd be better off by himself so from that day on he only met with the others in the group during the day. He said that he was a pilot and was a different kind of person than BROWN and the others. Others who were familiar to ROSE from that meeting were:

- "Little JOE" (GARMAN)
- GERRY PATRICK (HEMMING)
- DEMPSEY
- QUESTA (TODDY)
- and, TOM DUNCAN.

ROSE could not remember the name of the hotel but described its location in detail, saying it was at the second 90 degree bend in Biscayne Blvd., Miami, right on the canal.
