**Jail Riot Policy**

NEW YORK—New York City has adopted a policy of moving in immediately without negotiating with prisoners in the event of prison insurrection. "As much force as necessary," barring firearms, would be used to restore order.

Leo Zeferetti, president of the Correction Officers Benevolent Association of New York City, said this is "now the policy of New York City" and has the approval of Mayor John V. Lindsay.
