Joachim Joesten is the champion Warren Report critic, having turned out seven books on the subject thus far. And there will be more.

Three more books have been announced, but they will not be available at bookstores or newsstands. By summer Joesten will have ready a two-volume work entitled THE CASE AGAINST LYNDON B. JOHNSON. The first volume will deal with "his role in the plot before the murder" and the second "his role in the cover-up."

During World War Two Joesten was an assistant editor of Newsweek. Since then he has written books and magazine articles.

A second book will also be ready soon. It will be called THE CASE AGAINST THE KENNEDY CLAN ("They've known the truth all along—but cowards and expediency kept it quiet"). The third title is BIGGEST LIE EVER TOLD: Kennedy Murder Fraud—I helped expose it), which will be four volumes.
