Onassis by Joachim Josten (Tower, 95¢) is an unauthorized biography of the flamboyant shipping magnate and oil tycoon, from his childhood to his life of wealth and power today, his battles with the United States government, with the shipowners' associations, and with the oil companies. To the gossipy hard-back edition published in 1963 the author has added new chapters on the Ari-Jackie marriage, the supposed troubles between them, and on his troubles with the new regime in Greece.
