They didn't buy me, but they have found a way to freeze me out. So after the trip, I will print Vol. III and prepare for the jails they have waiting.

Fred, Zapruder told friends of mine he had been paid \$486,000 and that was 2 years ago. It is a ten year contract.

I think your work is outstanding. I will help any way I can except for money. Beginning in June, I'll print whatever you want printed. I mailed you a DCA_film -- it is yours.

Need any of my books -- just ask When I am in jail, I want to think: "God, I'm glad I printed that rather than wish I had printed it.
