Dear Ms. Davies,

While as a writer I am anxious for what I have written to be as available as possible for what you describe as the "enlightenment of our readers," it is impossible for me to give these books to the University of Michigan Library.

Thus I enclose an invoice for them.

All my work for 11 years now has been without subsidy, without regular income, and done by going into debt.

There has been no meaningful support for it, not even from those institutions that want it for permanent archival use.

My disappointment over the lack of support for a work that needs to be done is not the reason I can't give these books away, however.

Merely survival is. They are the only income I have and it is hardly enough to enable me to continue this work.
