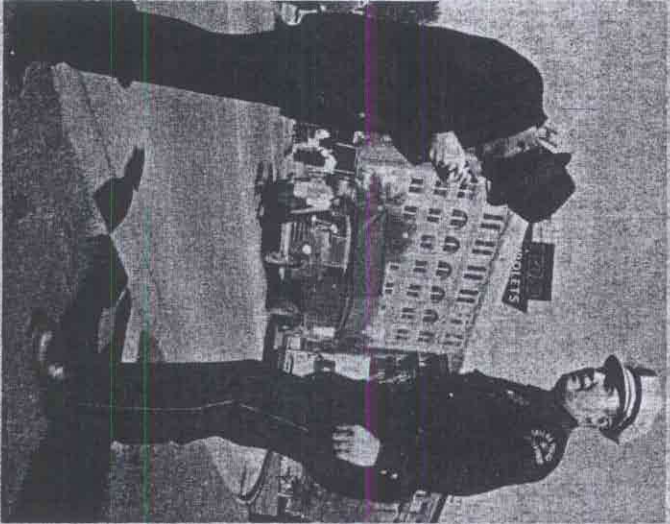
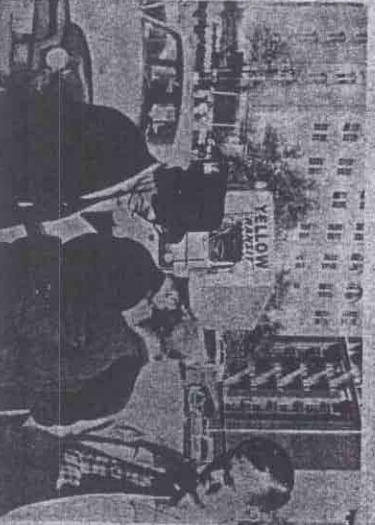
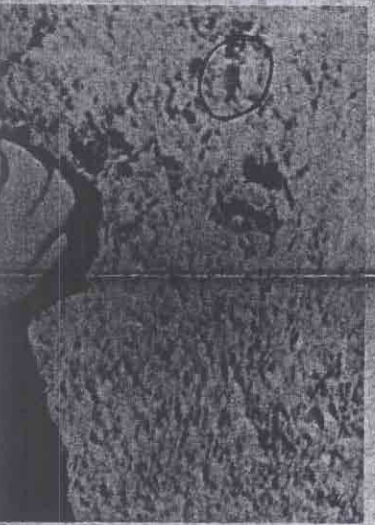
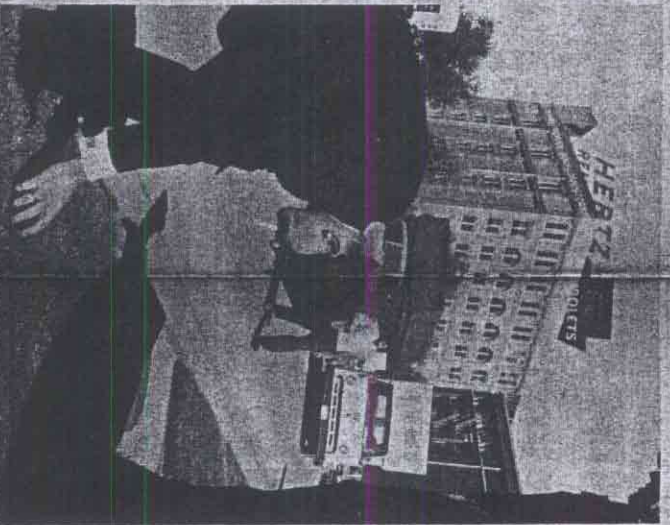
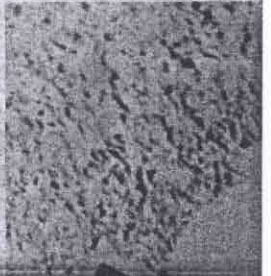


On this page is pictorial proof of an early coverup immediately after the killing of President John F. Kennedy. Deputy Sheriff Buddy Walthers and a Dallas policeman back away and permit a man to pick up a bullet about a foot from the south curb of Elm Street. Dallas Police Chief Jesse Curry said the man was an FBI man.



Buddy Walthers said the bullet was a .45 caliber slug, but it was never mentioned by the Authorities after that fateful afternoon. On reverse side of this sheet is evidence the coverup had not reached the editorial offices of this paper when this early edition went to press.

Jones has published the evidence concerning some of the top men in the nation - including Lyndon Johnson - being involved in the conspiracy.

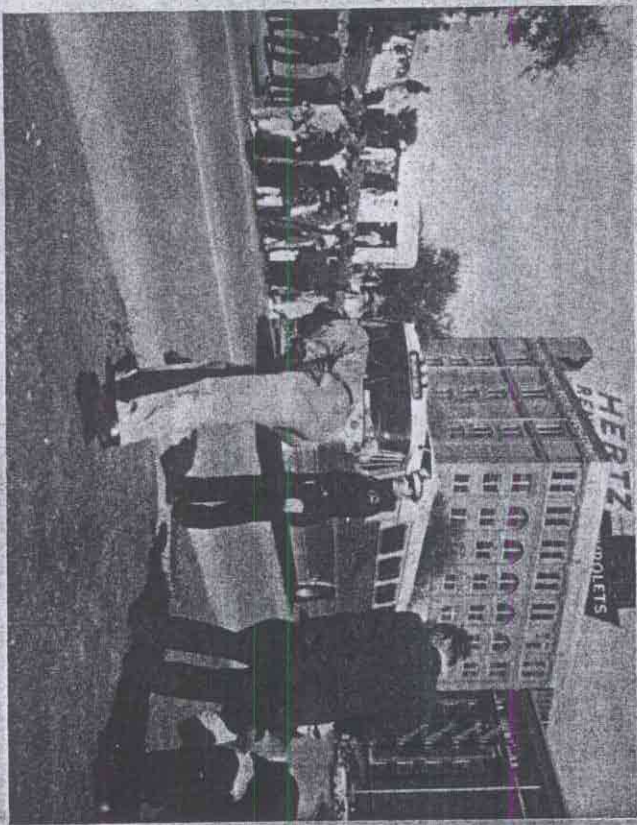

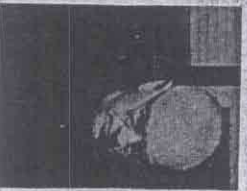
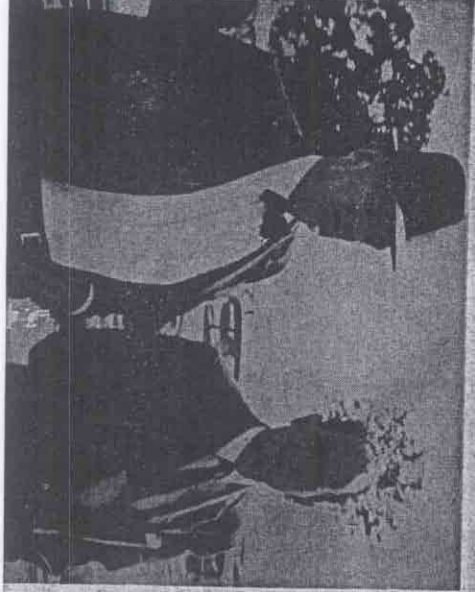

PORTRAIT OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY AT LAST SPEECH

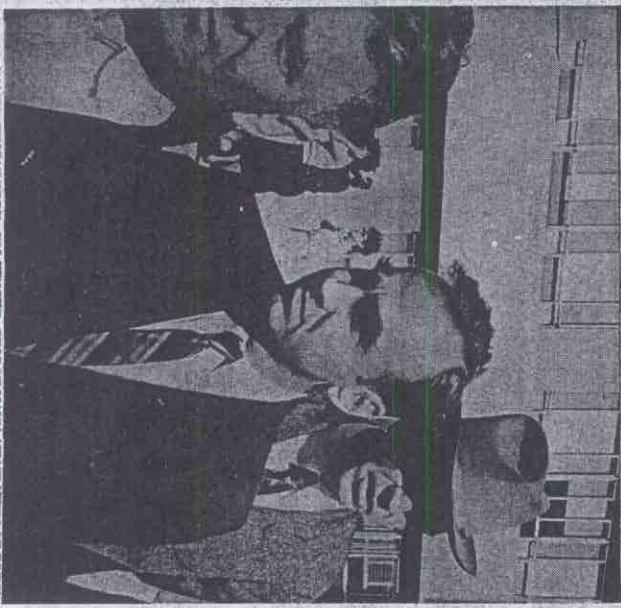
