I also understand from the press that there were press releases and/or personal comments in making the allouncement of these charges by spokesmen, including the Attorney General. I would like copies of any such added information as had been made available or as may in the future be.

If these 113 pages do not include the charges, I would also appreciate a copy of them.

These are serious accusations against a controversial public figure, I want to be as fully informed as possible for my writing, including any background material you may properly provide about the mature and duration of the investigation, the alleged "bagman", and the co-defendants. Thus I sould appreciate anything that in your opinion would help my understanding as well as my writing.
