10/9/69- Haiti invasione, indictments for (Ref earlier memo)

Yesterdey I dropped in on James O. Morris, of the DJ Internal Security Dib, fifth floor, Federal Triangle Bldg., to whom I had earlier been sent by the Criminal Div efter the Miemi indictments. He had indicated great interest in seeing me, copying my tapes and other files, etc. and had promised me s copy of the indictment. I never got it, never heard further.

He professed surpraie at this, and explained it was not him but Custons, to whom he had referred this, because they are in charge of such prosecutions.

He seis he'll send me the indictment (he drew it end they made but minor changes.

I told him I had a friend in touch with Demsgey and about to interview him. I seid if there were any cuestions to which they culd liek an effort made to get enswers, I would esk they be esked. He said this would not be evidence. I understood it would be hearsey. I said it might produce knowledge. He agreed. He presumed Dempsey had been permitted to return to Genada from British territory. I told him 1 had interview of Dempsey in the Ganedian press and he said he thought the y had them.

I also told him <sup>1</sup> had reason to believe (and why) the NSRP was pulling a nesty frame on the FBI 9and what it is). He said the place to take that was the FBI, because it involved their reputation. I replied that is the FBI would not even mnewer a request for my a copy of a press release from me this seemed a futility, and I presumed it would be his division that was interested in the NSRP. He agreed they have such an interest.
