

It has recently come to my attention that the Justice Department is opening the murder investigations of President John F. Kennedy and Dr. Martin Luther King. I would like to offer my services in this investigation.

My interest in the Kennedy murder started in 1966 when I met an Air Force Master Sergeant at St. Albans Naval Hospital, Queens, New York. This sergeant, an elderly man, was suffering from terminal cancer. He stated that on November 22, 1963 he was attached to Air Force One as an electronics technician. He further stated that after the President was shot a message was received over a military frequency that multiple assassins had attacked the President.

For the past thirteen years, I have studied the Kennedy assassination and have accrued a vast library on the subject. My research, although not original, has turned up some viable leads. For instance, a Secret Service agent stationed in the Dallas-Fort Worth area disappeared on November 22, 1963 yet his family still receives his paychecks. Please do not misconstrue this letter. I am not a crank; but I am sincerely interested in this crucial investigation. I am willing to join an investigative team and if that is not possible, will make myself available for an interview by investigative officers.
