Dear Mr. Secretary:

For some months now, on behalf of my client, Mr. Harold Weisberg, I have been seeking to get from the Department of Justice a copy of all documents supplied to the Ben/Street Megistrate's Court in Lendon by Mr. David Calcutt on behalf of the U.S. Government in the public proceeding to require the extradition of Mr. James Barl Ray in June-July, 1968. (See attached correspondence).

The Department of Justine has replied (evasively) that it does not have copies of such documents and (unevasively) that, even if it did have copies, they would not be unde available under the Freedom of Information Ast, despite the fact that the Lendon proceeding was public.

Does the Department of State, either in its files in Washington or leaden or elsewhere, have such documents or copies thereof, and will they be unde available promptly to Mr. Weisberg per this request?

As the Freedom of Information Act talls for prompt responses on requests for information, I sincerely hope you will favor us with a prompt and unequivocal reply,
