I have enjoyed reading your interesting book. I wish that the type were larger.

There are several comments that I would like to make. First, you state that you were unable to find Jack Ruby's address in the Report. If you will read the testimony of George Senator in the Commission Hearings, you will find that he stated he shared an apartment with Ruby at either 223 or 225 South Ewing Street at the time that Ruby shot Oswald. I believe that this is not very far from Tippitt ^{WHERE} was shot.

Secondly, do you not qualify as a bona fide investigator who can see the Kennedy autopsy pictures and X-rays with the Kennedy family's permission? Have you tried to see them?

Thirdly, has anyone tried to interview Miss Mary Moonman to find out what she saw in the Polaroid picture that she took at the assassination site? This should not be too difficult.
