Thanks for your letter of 8/15. I, too, am sorry the interview was cut short. Their failure to call back when they said they would also disappoints and causes wonder, especially because I was using those apparently profane words "FBI" at the time of the cut. I did, however, stay by the phone the next two days.

They can call me without warning. I went through the book and marked the specific pages with paperclips and made a note of the more important ones so that if they do again phone, I can read from the documents themselves, which, I think, will be a switch and much more authoritative than <sup>the</sup> writing about them. The reaction I have gotten seems to bear this out. People are impressed with the documents themselves, which they have never been permitted to see before.

Thanks for your effort.

I spoke to Bob once after he returned.
