Perhaps you'd like a deeper interview on the editing of the missing slides of the Zapruder movie. Background is in Photographic Whitewash about p 20.

You promised to send me old rechargeable batteries and used tapes that I can reuse. If you can, it could be helpful. Also, those few things I asked you to get for the Norelco machine (I have an identical one in a different case, Voice of Music, for special reasons having to do with no cash involved) I'd like them as soon as possible, for I'll be leaving on two short trips soon and would need them then.

After I started this letter I got a call from another young man who is working with me. He has located Nancy Perrin Rich, who is terrified, has remarried again and has moved, reacts in a way that tends to make us think our hunch on Walter A. (Jack) Youngblood in "The Devil To Pay" is correct - that is, that he could have been the Youngblood in her testimony. Please tell Steve. Also ask him to canvass our friends to see if they can recall anything that happened in Grand Rapids, Mich., that may figure in any of the evidence. This could be important.
