Information from the records of Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, New Orleans, Louisiana, concerning toll records from December, 1962, through June, 1963, for HUNter 8-4326 was furnished on December 2, 1963, to SA NATHAN O. BROWN by [REDACTED] Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, New Orleans, Louisiana. [REDACTED] stated that the previous check of the records for this number indicated that there were no tolls available prior to the July 5, 1963 bill. [REDACTED] stated that additional toll records which go back through the December, 1962 bill were located this date in a storage bin in one of the rooms of the Metairie District Office.

The information regarding the check of the Western Union records at New Orleans, was supplied by [REDACTED] Western Union, New Orleans, Louisiana. He advised that Western Union records are available only through a subpoena duces tecum.

From past experience it is known that you cannot check records of the New Orleans Sewerage and Water Board by name.
