In 'Copter Jailbreak

MEXICO CITY — The wife
of Joel David Kaplan, the alleged CIA agent who escaped
with a fellow prisoner by helicopter from Santa Marta
Prison a week ago today,
doubts if she will ever see
him again.

Mrs. Irma Kaplan, a petite Mexican who wed Kaplan by proxx in 1965, told the Associated Press of a visit with him in the prison the day of the escape.

"Well, I'll see you tomorrow," she told him.

"Okay," he replied, offering no hint that a helicopter would swoop down in the prison yard that dusk for the pickup.

Kaplan was serving a 28-year sentence for murder when he and Carlos Contrers as, 24, of Venezuela were lifted out of the prison, then went their separate ways in planes. One report, never verified, was that Kaplan went to Sausalito.
