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Dear Hal:

I had a chance to go over my notes and bring you further up to date with respect to my recent visit to Dallas plus some additional items on Oliver Stone which you wanted me to send you if I came across them.

The enclosures I've included deal with the Dallas Symposium, Oliver Stone's movie plus some interesting book reviews (Mark North's book on J. Speaking about lists I just received a "Master Researcher Directory" dated November, 1991. It is put out by Gordon Winslow out of Miami. My name and Paul Hoch's name are in it. It contains 213 names and one surprising

There is another name included in the "Directory" if he is somebody I had a long conversation with when I was at the Symposium. I was very impressed with his knowledge of the JFK autopsy. He definitely knew what he was talking about (he didn't think much of the "Lifton" alteration of the body scenario). Anyway, his name is DR. LOUIS KARTSONIS.

Kartsonis is an ophthalmologist and he told me an interesting story about his efforts to look at the JFK autopsy photos. Kartsonis said he had written to the Kennedy family to get permission to see the autopsy material. Burke Marshall wrote him back (around 1979 I believe) and told Kartsonis he failed to meet any of the three basic requirements for looking at the material. Kartsonis persisted & wrote again & said his persistence paid off. This time Marshall allowed Kartsonis the opportunity to see the photos (I'm not sure if Kartsonis mentioned anything else). One thing I recall Kartsonis telling me that one of the photos clearly showed a hole in the back of the head. Of course, I wasn't in a position to have him expand on what he did see but I think you should write him and learn what he found. I'm sure he has notes on this which he must've kept.

Another name in the "Directory" I received is Dave Perry. I'm sure you know him because the latest issue of the "Third Decade" has an article by him on the Poscoe White and he thoroughly demolishes that fiasco. In fact when I spoke to Perry whom I met outside of Larry Howard's office he told me details about the Poscoe White which were not included in his article that by themselves - would've flattened the White story. It's a good thing the Symposium didn't include the White thing in any of its panels!
