On April 17, 1968, ANITA KATZWINKEL, 1727 North Garfield Place, Los Angeles, California, was reinterviewed in an effort to determine if VINCE STELLY, employed by Desilu Studios, could be identical to "VINCE", last name unknown, who was reportedly an acquaintance of GINGER NANCE and ANITA KATZWINKEL. It was noted that VINCE STELLY is described as a Negro male. Upon reinterview, KATZWINKEL definately stated that the "VINCE" known to her and GINGER was a caucasian male and he resided in the Hollywood area, address unknown, and he did not reside on Fifth Avenue in Los Angeles where VINCE STELLY resides.
