dullest deliberative body. ST. PETERSBURG, Fla.—Roy H. Kellerman, 69, the Secret Service agent who was riding in the front seat of the car when President John F. Kennedy was assassinated in Dallas, died here March 22. The cause of death was not reported.

Mr. Kellerman served with the White House Secret Service detail during the administrations of presidents Roosevelt, Truman, Eisenhower, Kennedy and Johnson. He was assistant administrator of the service when he retired in 1968.
