Garrison Scores Robert Kennedy

NEW YORK (UPI) — Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison claims Sen. Robert F. Kennedy has "done everything he could to obstruct" his investigation of President Kennedy's assassination.

"It is quite apparent to me that for one reason or another he does not want the truth to be brought out," Garrison said yesterday in an interview. "Perhaps he can explain better than I can why his political career is so important."

Garrison added: "I have to conclude that he feels the development of truth about the assassination, catching the real assassins of Jack Kennedy, would interfere with his political career."
