Kennedy discounts JFK murder theories

NORTHAMPTON, Mass. (AP) — Sen. Edward M. Kennedy, D-Mass., said Tuesday he has seen no evidence warranting a new investigation into the assassination of his brother, president John F. Kennedy.

The Massachusetts lawmaker, asked about recent allegations that the CIA may have been involved in the 1963 Dallas shooting, said that if new evidence is found, then another inquiry should be made.
