## lackie's Secret Testimony on JFK Assassination

## . . . 45 Congressmen Demand New Probe Into Kennedy, King & Wallace Shootings By CHRIS FULLER

Forty-five U.S. congressmen are demanding a "full and complete investigation" by the House of Representatives into the assassinations of John F. Kennedy, Robert Kennedy and Martin Luther King and the attempted slaying of George

Spurring the demand is sensational testimony before the Warren Commission by Jackie Kennedy - published here for the first time that deepens doubts about two of the commission's basic findings.

Investigators believe her testimony challenges the commission's conclusions that JFK was shot from the rear by a lone gunman - Lee Harvey Oswald - and that the same bullet struck both the President

and then-Texas Gov. John Connally. Giving voice to the suspicions that are swirling around the corridors of Congress, Rep. Henry Gonzalez (D.-Tex.) said he sees a "possible pattern" in the three murders and the Wallace

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And Rep. Charles H. Wilson (D.-Calif.) agreed: "There could be links in all three assassinations and in the attempt on Wallace's life."

Gonzalez has introduced a resolution in the House of Representatives, co-sponsored by 44 of his colleagues — Democrats and Republicans — urging creation of a select seven-member House panel to investigate the crimes.

Gonzalez hopes to add more co-sponsors by the end of the year, when he plans to bring the proposal to the

The resolution would direct the spe-cial committee "to conduct a full and a complete investigation and study of the circumstances surrounding the death of John F. Kennedy, Robert F. Kennedy and Martin Luther King and the attempted assassination of George

Wallace."

Gonzalez said that before the Watergate scandal, "I didn't pay much attention to investigators who repeatedly claimed there was a massive conspiracy to cover up the JFK assassination.
"But since Watergute, I think these conspiracy claims should be viewed in a different light."

A key question Gonzalez wants and

A key question Gonzalez wants answered is the whereabouts of Howard Hunt — one of the major Watergate figures — on the day of JFK's assassination.

"I think it's more than coincidence that Hunt had been head of the CIA station in Mexico City and that Lee Harvey Oswald made a mysterious visit to Mexico City shortly before the assassination," he said.

"We again run into the name of Howard Hunt in the attempt on Wallace's life. An hour after the shooting, Hunt was sent to Arthur Bremer's apartment on Charles Colson's orders."

Colson was counsel to President Richard M. Nixon. Bremer was con-victed of the 1972 attack on Wallace. Gonzalez was in the motorcade when President Kennedy was slain in Dallas on Nov. 22, 1963 — and he's still dis-turbed by his recollections of the event. "I have never mentioned this to any.

'I have never mentioned this to anyone before. But when the first shot sounded, the cars were already at a complete halt or just crawling," he told The ENQUIRER.

"Odd that we should have come to a virtual stop even before the first shot, at that exact spot."

A major point troubling congressmen is testimony to the Warren Commission by President Kennedy's widow that investigators insist shows JFK was shot from the front.
In the testimony — declassified in 1972 but published here by The EN-

The former First Lady's previously unpublished testimony also disputes the commission's finding that Gov. Connally, riding in the front seat of the Kennedy car, was wounded by the same bullet that pierced the President's head.

Asked whether she recalled "one or more shots," Jackie replied:

"Well, there must have been two because the one that made me turn around was Gov. Connally yelling.

"And it used to confuse me because first I remembered there were three and I used to think my husband didn't make any sound when he was shot. And Gov. Connally screamed like a

Congressmen are also paying in-creasing attention to a "psychological stress" evaluation of Oswald's voice. Some analysts maintain that a lack of stress signs in Oswald's taped voice after the assassination shows that he was telling the truth when he denied shooting anyone.

Washington lawyer Mark Lane, one of the most vocal proponents of the conspiracy theory, said he is certain the CIA was linked to the four crimes.

"I believe a new investigation into the JFK assassination will be the key which unleaks the scorets of a whole

which unlocks the secrets of a whole decade of deceit," Lane told The EN-QUIRER.
'And I think that through this inves-

tigation we are going to find out why Robert Kennedy was killed, why Martin Luther King was killed and why there was an attempt on the life of George Wallace." Lane added: "There may not be a

single motive which links the three assassinations and the attempt on Wallace's life, but I think it is possible there was a single source."
