ABSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY NORMAN LEE ELEINS RACIAL MATTERS

On 10/29/63, Chief of Police JESSE E. CURRY telephonically contacted me at the YBI office late in the afternoon. Chief CURRY stated that the Chief of Police at Denton, Chief ANDERSON, had contacted him relative to one WORMAN LKE KLKINS. He stated ANDERSON told him he felt ELKINS, who resided in Denison, Texas, might possibly be organizing some action to embarrass the President on his visit to Dallas. CURRY asked if the YBI had a photograph and background information concerning KLKINS. I told him the name was not familiar to me but I would check our files and call him back.

After reviewing the files of this effice, I called Chief CURRY back and told him we did have some background information and a photograph of MORMAN LEE ELKINS. He stated he would on the following day send Lt. JACK REVILL to our office for the information and photograph.

I attempted to reach FORREST SORRELS, U. B. Secret Berrice, at his office, but did not reach line at that time. I did reach him at approximately 6 p.m. that date.

On the morning of 10/30/63, Lt. JACK EXVILL of the Intelligence Unit of the Dallas PD contacted me at the effice of the FBI in Dallas. He stated he wanted to get the background information on MORMAN LEE ELKINS of Denison, Texas. I discussed this previously with EA WALLACE R. HEITMAN, at which time SA HEITMAN reviewed the background information with Lt. REVILL. Prior to reviewing the background information I called Mr. SORRELLS on the telephone and told him that Lt. REVILL of the Dallas PD on instructions of Chief of Police CURRY was going to Denison, Texas, to interview KLKINS. I also gave him information Chief CURRY had furnished this effice. I teld Mr. SORRELLS that REVILL was in the effice and if he desired to talk with him by telephone he could do so and make.
