"Under investigation - Police officers examine auto near Ambassador after a key discovered on shooting suspect (Sirhan) was found to fit ignition. Officials later established that vehicle and its owner, a hotel employee, had no connection with assassination attempt."

February 3rd, a.m., Lillian heard a voice report from Walter Rodgers, Metro Media News Service, Washington, D.C., Rogers said that secret service had a file on a kitchen worker at Ambassador Hotel. This man's car key was found in Sirhan's pocket by police when Sirhan was arrested. Rogers said secret service file showed that this man (Robert Gindroz) had previously threatened life of President of the United States. (Didn't hear which president.) GINDROZ NAME
WAS NOT MENTIONED IN THIS REPORT.

Note: Police found Sirhan's car parked near Ambassador with keys, wallet and i.d. in the car. Gindroz car was also parked near the Ambassador Hotel.
