Three prominent Los Angeles men have told The ENQUIRER they are convinced there was more than one man involved in the Robert F. Kennedy assassination — and that they saw some of the other plotters escaping immediately after the fatal shooting.

According to their information:

A Trantic-looking young man rushed out of the front door of the Embassy Room, the ballroom at the Ambassador Hotel, seconds after

Senator Kennedy was shot

He was carrying something wrapped in a paper under his arm, and was followed by men shouting "Stop that man!" The young man began running and was lost in the crowds and confusion.

Also four other young mean came out of the front door of the ballroom Carrying a fifth, who looked as if he had been wounded. They all vanished into the crowd outside the ballroom.


