Others Hit By Assassin Improving

LOS ANGELES, June 6 (AP) — Five bystanders hurt in the shooting that killed Sen. Robert F. Kennedy were in improved condition today.

One was scheduled to go home shortly. He is Ira Goldstein of Encino, hit by a bullet in the left hip. Encino Hospital spokesmen said he was doing "very well."

Paul Schrade, 30, regional director for the United Auto Workers, was reported in "pretty good shape" by Kaiser Foundation Hospital. Nurses said he was conscious and coherent.

William Weisel, 30, of Washington, a newsman for the American Broadcasting Co., was in satisfactory condition at Kaiser.

Irwin Stroll, 17, was in good condition at Midway Hospital.

Elizabeth Evans had a bullet removed from her scalp and was in satisfactory condition at Huntington Memorial Hospital.
