> His client is Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, the slender 24-year-old Jordanian who is accused of fir-ing the bullet that fatally wounded Kennedy last June 5.

> The public defender's office had been representing Sirhan since his arrest, but he had said from the start he would prefer to have a representative of the Los Angeles bar represent him.

Parsons told a newsman he had not met Sirhan but would visit him Wednesday.

WORK HARD

"I have been interested in the case all along," he said, "and I've thought about it and studied it. I'm just going to work hard and do the very best I can."

Asked his age, Parsons said he's in his late 60s-"exact ages aren't important."

First word that Parsons would take the case came from attorney A. L. Wirin of the American Civil Liberties Union, who has consulted Sirhan regularly since his arrest and helped him find a defender.

Wirin said that now that Sirhan has obtained the counsel of his choice, "his constitutional right to counsel is being fully protected and the interest of the American Civil Liberties Union in his case is ended," Wirin add-
