

## 1 Seized in Grocer Slaying; Revenge for RFK Theorized

CHICAGO (AP)—Police today arrested Aaron Myers, 19, in connection with the death of a Jordanian grocer who they had speculated may have been shot in revenge for the assassination of Sen. Robert F. Kennedy.

Myers, a Negro, was charged with the murder of Abier Rayyan, 55, the father of nine children, policeman Robert Bonner said.

Rayyan was shot in the head Saturday as he bent over a vegetable bin in his store, his daughter, Zudheia, 22, who witnessed the shooting, told police.

She said two Negro men

entered, one of them pulled out a pistol and they walked silently to where Rayyan was working. The gunman put the pistol behind Rayyan's left ear and fired twice, she said. The second shot missed.

Police were searching for another man.

After the shooting, police noted the man charged with murdering Kennedy, Sirhan Bishara Sirhan, 24, is a native of Jordan. They indicated at the time the Rayyan killing might have been in revenge.

Rayyan left Jordan 16 years ago and lived in South America until 1963, when he came to the United States.
