CUBAN EXILE RECALLS WITH SIRHAN MYT 6113/68 MIAMI, June 12 (AP)—A man

who described himself as a for-mer army officer with Fidel Castro, said today that Sirhan B. Sirhan, charged with the assassination of Senator Robert F. Kennedy, told him before Senator Kennedy's death that "what we need in the United States is another Fidel Castro." The exile, José Duarte, said he argued with Sirhan and scuffled with him. He told a news conference that the incident occurred about three weeks ago in Hollywood, Calif.

In Hollywood, a man identified by Mr. Duarte as his host on the occasion, Rober Leammle, denied that there had been a scuffle. He also denied that anyone he could recognize from subsequent news photos as Sirhan was persent.
