

Young Kennedy Says Leave Case Closed

NEW YORK — Robert F. Kennedy Jr. says his family is satisfied with the investigation of his father's assassination and does not want the case reopened.

"It's a painful thing for my entire family to see this whole thing reopened and we're satisfied with what was found," the Harvard senior said yesterday.



"I think they ought to drop it," Kennedy, who is 21, said about efforts to determine whether Sirhan B. Sirhan acted alone in the 1968 fatal shooting of Sen. Robert F. Kennedy on a presidential primary campaign trip in Los Angeles.

He was here to publicize a film syndicated for television on his experiences in Kenya last year.
