Here is one of the stories you reugested -- from the L.A. Times on the destruction of evidence in the R.F.K. case.

The enclosed Times story by William Farr covers only the L.A. city youncil Meeting of Thursday morning, August 21st, and not of the L.A. police commission meeting of that same afternoon.

I talked to our correspondent who covered that meeting for us and for Pacifica radio in Los Angeles (KPEK), and he told me that Farr was at the morning meeting—but not at the afternmon one. This explains why the Times missed everything but the ceiling panels, because they were discussed in the morning; but the other itmes were also discussed at the police commission meeting in the P.M.

As our correspondent Jeffrey K ye tells it, and he has both notes and actual recordings to back him up, xxxixixx acting police chief Daryl Gates of the Los Angeles Police Department admitted to the Police Commission in the afternoon of August 21, 1975:

(1) The eailing panels were destroyed under and order signed with max 26 x x 1969 are the control of the contro

(2) Destroyed the door jams under the same order.

(3) Destroyed the spectrographic analysis under the same order.

(4) Had X-rays of the ceiling panels made, but they "can not be located."

(5) Gates also said that Kennedy's left coat sleeve is missing, saying that police probably never had custody of the sleeve — that it was likely removed by doctors who treated R.F.K. and was lost.
