

CBS seeks RFK files

LOS ANGELES (UPI) — The Columbia Broadcasting System (CBS) filed suit in federal court yesterday to force the Los Angeles police department to release a 10-volume summary of its investigation into the assassination of Robert F. Kennedy in 1968. Sirhan B. Sirhan was convicted of Kennedy's murder and is serving a life prison sentence. In past months, there have been increasing demands to reopen the case to determine whether a "second gunman" may have been involved in the shooting. The police have refused to make the summary of their investigation open on grounds it could invade the privacy of innocent persons connected with the case. CBS claimed in its suit that California's public record act of 1968 provides that such summaries are open to inspection by any citizen.
