RFK evidence destroyed

LOS ANGELES (UPI) — Police have confirmed that bullet-pocked ceiling panels and other material gathered in investigating the assassination of Sen. Robert Kennedy has been destroyed, but that all evidence used to convict Sirhan Sirhan as the assassin is still intact. There has been continuing controversy over whether a "second gun," besides Sirhan's, was fired when Kennedy was killed in the Ambassador Hotel kitchen in 1968. It was hoped that the number of bullet holes in the hotel ceiling panels might shed some light on that contention.
