RFK Bullets Identified

Los Angeles—Three fatal bullet fragments removed from the head of Robert F. Kennedy were identified in court yesterday in the preliminary phase of the re-investigation of his 1968 assassination.

Criminologist DeWayne Wolfer inspected the tiny slugs encased in glass vials and also identified bullet fragments removed from the bodies of bystanders in the volley fired in a pantry of the Ambassador Hotel.

One of the remnants was taken from the body of Paul Schrede, a union official who was at Kennedy's side and who is one f the prime movers in reopening the case to determine whether a "second gun" other than the one wrenched from Sirhan B. Sirhan was fired.

Seven independant experts will conduct tests on the bullets in the next weeks in an attempt to resolve the "second gun" question.
