Kershaw Claims He Has 'Raoul's' Photo

Jack Kershaw, James Earl Ray's attorney, said yesterday he has a photograph of the mysterious "Raoul" who Ray claims gave him instructions to buy the gun used to shoot Martin Luther King Jr.

Kershaw said he "discovered" the photo in the process of investigating Ray's case. He said he will not release it until Ray is recaptured "or something happens."

The attorney said he had been planning to release the picture before Ray made his escape from Brushy Mountain State Prison Friday.

"I feel it would be a

disservice to my client if I released the photo without his permission," said Kershaw. He said he found the picture about 10 days ago.
