and they all "live in rather close proximity to each  
other in Toronto" but never knew each other (85)

Miss Maura Baker, BOAC receptionist London, exchanged

refund, about \$14.00.

Inspector Passow (sic) Portuguese National Police Service  
entered Portugal 5/16/68, left 5/17/68. Stayed at  
Hotel Portugal. (86)

Miss Monnelle T. Lopez, Brazilian Embassy, London - 5/15/68  
to have connection from Sneya to Ray (87)

Mr. Fama, Port Police London, checked both passports  
& allowed Ray to take flight to London 5/17 (87)

London 5/28-6/5; Port Hotel 6/5-6/8

Canadian police 1 Det Sgt Sneya & Passport photo as Ray (88)

"Through the cooperative efforts in law enforcement  
officers of New Scotland Yard in London, and the  
Portuguese International Police, the search started  
in Roman George Sneya" (88)

When Ray appeared at Heathrow 11:30 AM 6/8, Det.  
Sgt. Philip Falkirk Birch, "who was used next  
to the immigration officer checking passports, when he  
Defendant presented two passports... I immedi-

ately Sgt Birch, based on inquiries that had  
previously come to him, asked the Defendant to talk  
with him. With reference to these passports (89) went  
to Police office, where he said he had by day 89

4) Near the bag found 38 unopened quills - used Liberty  
Tickets known to Binns & Hub of unhealed prints and  
"various items of correspondence" "not particularly"  
relevant. 90

Chief Constable Bryan, judge just report 22 yrs  
who had given Hester with Capt. Butler, obtained  
Phip's prints, compared with those of from U.S. and

name and photograph of James Earl Ray" (445)  
6/24 compared with London prints & those taken  
when Ray was released to Shelby County jail and  
found all the same 95 (also other items)

Weyer "The death they was identical in all  
physical characteristics with the give looked 30.66  
Springfield cartridges found in the bag in  
front of camp. The Kentridge case, in fact  
been fired on the 30.06 rifle. That the death they  
removed from the body contained lead and some  
impressions and direction of thrust consistent with  
those that were in the barrel of this rifle. \* That
