C. 20530, within thirty days from receipt of this letter. The envelope and the letter should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Appeal" or "Information Appeal." Please cite the Freedom of Information-Privacy Acts (FOIPA) number assigned to your request so that it may be easily identified.

Processing of Memphis Field Office file 100-4105 captioned "Martin Luther King, Jr., Security Matters" has been initiated and will be furnished to you upon its completion.

Investigation in this case was predicated upon information received from the reservations office, American Airlines, to the effect that a male individual, identity unknown, had called that office on 4/1/68 and threatened to bomb the plane which was to bring Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING back to Memphis.

The above information was immediately furnished to the Bureau and to the Atlanta Office by referenced tel.

Inasmuch as all the information furnished by the unknown person making the above mentioned call was untrue, it is recommended that this case be closed.
