N.B. the [redacted] paper seems to set the matter to rest because:

- 1) MLK and associates arrived Lorraine Hotel 10:30am 4/3/68
- 2) [redacted]'s "handled" notation is dated 4/3/68 which would likely preclude any press dissemination in time to influence MLK and associates. (b1)(7)(C)
- 3) Bu file review fails to indicate any news article which would be an outgrowth of the Moore proposal
- 4) "Memphis Commercial Appeal" was reviewed 3/28 - 4/4/68 w/o indication dissemination of the Moore proposal.

Important to note is Bu policy re: authorization of misurs. Policy was that written authority from AG was unnecessary. Authority was vested in the Director or his designees based on 5/20/54 AG Herbert Brownell memo. However, on 3/20/65 this policy was amended and AG authority was required.
