TY PERSONALITY BOOKED IN CASE

Allegedly Kept Fee Meant for Garrison

MIAMI (AP) — Radio-TV personality and columnist Larry King was arrested Monday and charged with grand larcemy in connection with a case involving New Orleans District
Atty. James Garrison and Florida fihancier Lewis E. Wolfson,
police said.

Officers said Wolfson alleged that King kept a \$5,000 contribution meant for Garrison as part of an arrangement Wolfson made to finance the district attorney's controversial investigation of the assassination of President John J. Kennedy.

King, who broadcasts for WIOD radic and WTVJ-television, was released on his own recognizance after being booked at the Dade County Jail.

The management of WTVJ released a statement which said King would stay on the lair. He had requested a leave of absence, the station said, but WTVJ had decided not to grant the leave of absence until a court of law decided his guilt or innocepce.
