Dear Mr. Shea,

While this letter deals with C.A.75-1996, I write it pursuant to a phone call from Jim Lesar this afternoon. That call followed conversation with Doug Mitchell of your staff with regard to the enclosures. Here is the background:

A reporter spent much of last Saturday here going over some of my King assassination files. In the course of seeking those records of interest to him I found a copy of an OPR record I had made for checking for which I had not found time. I had read every word in all the MURKIN files I received and I recalled no record as is described in this OPR record. The marks in the margin were made as reminders to me when I did the checking.

This OPR record is its summary of Section 78 of FBI HQ MURKIN records.

The language I did not recall having seen in any form is "In connection with conspiracy claims note the memorandum (Serial 5651) that Coretta King and Rev. Abernathy wanted to keep the conspiracy possibilities alive for SCLC monetary support reasons. The basis for this allegation is a wire tap."

A check of Serial 5651 shows there is no such content in it. So I checked the worksheets. As is not uncommon with the copies provided to me this one is quite unclear. I have put an arrow in the margin to direct your attention to the right one. It describes this record as an internal memo of 3/17/69. It reflects that the memo was of but a single page and that this page was released to me, with excisions under claim of (7)(C) and (D).

But the page released to me not only says no such thing - there are no excisions!

I feel reasonably certain that if you obtain the full Serial you will find that it consists of more than a single page and that it does have the content reflected in the OPR notes. If this is the case then the FBI was pretty dirty in this. It then has to have lied about the number of pages and to have withheld what reflects FBI wire-tapping the year after Dr. King was killed, almost a full year later. All but 16 days of a year.

You can decide for yourself whether (7)(D) also is appropriate for such withholding.

When I learned this I took it up with Jim. Today he told me that Doug Mitchell had checked and found that Ralph Harp's records reflect the record was of but a single page. However, the analyst was Higgins, not Harp, as the worksheet shows.

It appears to me that this shows that the worksheets are essential in such cases and that the FBI may well have reasons other than conveyed to you for refusing them to me in the JFK releases. Without the worksheets it is impossible to know what exemption is claimed, how many pages may be withheld and even if not recorded serials are withheld. Those not recorded are not numbered.

I have not sent copies to Mrs. King or Dr. Abernathy in the belief that the Department might prefer doing this. I also have not told anyone else to protect the rights of the reporter in question.

I would appreciate a clear copy of the full Serial and of a corrected worksheet.
