Since speaking to you I have spoken to a psychiatrist. He tells me it is unlikely that the hospital will give you a set of Godfrey's medical records but would to a lawyer or doctor. I also understand that Dr. Butterworth is a patient at Pineville. I do think you should have these records.

The letter to the Secret Service local office could be simple, quoting what Bill says he was told at the hospital and comparing that with what you were told by them. You should also ask for specification of the reason for their interest, what caused it and why it continues. As of the time of his transfer and as of the time of their stated initial interest, their duties covered the President and Vice President only.

As we discussed, I would appreciate copies. Herewith carbon paper.
