## Paraphrase (from tape):

Sen. Cook says Dita Beard memo which appeared in "Sunday" (19 Mar?) issue of NYTimes - which does not include the initial D - is labelled a photocopy, but that the memo in "today's" Washington Post - which does include the initial D - is labelled a reproduction. Cook makes the point that a "reproduction" does not mean it is a "photocopy."

Cook also says Hume "spent a great deal of time telling us that [Mrs. Beard] said, 'Well, I know that's mine because that's my initial and I put it there,'" but that Hume did not have this statement in his notes.
