HERMAN KOHLMAN, Assistant District Attorney, Parish of Orleans, advised that he is familiar with DAVID FERRIE from his past experience as a news reporter. KOMLMAN said he prepared a feature story on PERRIE's activities several years ago. He advised that he heard that FERRIE was mentioned in connection with being associated with LEE HARVEY OSWALD, and he talked to JACK MARTIN. a private investigator who "refreshed his memory" shout FERRIE. Based upon these facts, the District Attorney's Office instituted an investigation involving FERRIE. He advised thes FERRIE was interviewed by members of the District Attorney's staff and denied knowing LEE HARVEY OSWALD or having any information about OSWALD's being in the Civil Air Patrol.

received information from the Intelligence Unit of the New Orleans Police Department who had previously conducted inquiries regarding PERRIE's connection with Cuba or Cuban activities. An unknown police officer had told the Intelligence Division of the New Orleans Police Department that he was in the Civil Air Patrol with LEE HARVEY OSWALD and that FERRIE knew OSWALD.

KOHLMAN advised that because FERRIE must have known OSWAID and because it appeared he had lied when he denied knowing OSWAID, FERRIE was arrested.
