I'd appreciate an unsarked copy to give to my lapper for possible use in my FOIA cases because of the reference in it to the "assigned number 36.384." No number has yet been assigned to any of my requests despite my asking precosely this of Director Kelley.

Director Kelley does not, of course, write all the letters that bear his signature.

I don't blame you for marking his claim that their "central index" does not have any reference to alleged warnings about Pearl "arbor.

You should know that whatever the central index may be it excludes most FBI records.

You say that I "have been in Pearl Harbor as agent." I donet know what gave you this idea. I've never been there and I was never an agent in that sense. When I was in intelligence I was an analyst, not a speck.

I appreciate anything that can be helpful in my work. Director "elley's letter can be. But I do wish you could appreciate what \hat{I} have explained to you many times, that I just cannot do anything to help you and do not have the time my work requires. I therefore want very much to suiddinnecessary letter-suriting.

Thanks for referring me to the Midnight article, which I have not seen.
