Re Minneapolis teletypes 3/27/67 regarding  
actions of subject KROMAN.

Attached is a copy of the transcript of the  
proceedings held on March 27, 1967, before U. S.  
District Court Judge EDWARD J. DEVITT, Chief Judge,  
at Bismarck, North Dakota, in the above-entitled matter.

It should be noted that the conclusions of  
the Court, as outlined on page 1137, find that KROMAN  
may be presently insane or otherwise so mentally  
incompetent as to be unable to understand the proceedings  
against him or properly assist in his own defense. The  
Court revoked his bail and committed him to the custody  
of the U. S. Marshal for appropriate examination at the  
Medical Facilities, Springfield, Missouri, for a period  
of 45 days more or less, as needed, under Section 4244,  
Title 18, USC.

KROMAN's allegations with respect to his  
independent investigation of the KENNEDY assassination  
are set forth on page 1082 and succeeding pages. It will  
be noted that it is at this point that KROMAN makes mention  
of his alleged assault in Memphis, Tennessee.

The Bureau will be advised of all developments.
