Re Harry "ean/ James Horowits and the FBI: Deen is quite a liar. The FBI has a legit. beef in complaining about taking Deen straight when he has gone publis with such inconsistent accounts of the supposedly same thing. At the same time the FBI's word can t be taken. I would be willing to believe that he was not a numbered informant, though. He might have been a source, as he was for the Congressional witch-hunters. He is a dubious character and a liar.

I do not subscribe th Penn Jones' newsletter or to any other. Not uncommonly some are sent to me. I have not seen his bit on "Jean Souetre." If he was in Dallas on the day of tye assassination end if he was with French intelligence, he could have been there on any of a wide variety of errands having nothing to do with that crime. I'd be interested in what Boxley's files hold on Farewell America because long before it was printed, with some assisting from Garrison, I warned Garrison that it was a fake. Boxley was with Garrison for a long time after that. And it is a fake. I know that Garrison did send Steve Jaffe to Europe on that project. Steve was to have returned with much documentation. My recollection is that his hands were close to empty.

I always plan to publish new books when I can. Right now I'm fighting for time to return to writing. There will not be any new one in the near future. When there is we'll let you know.
